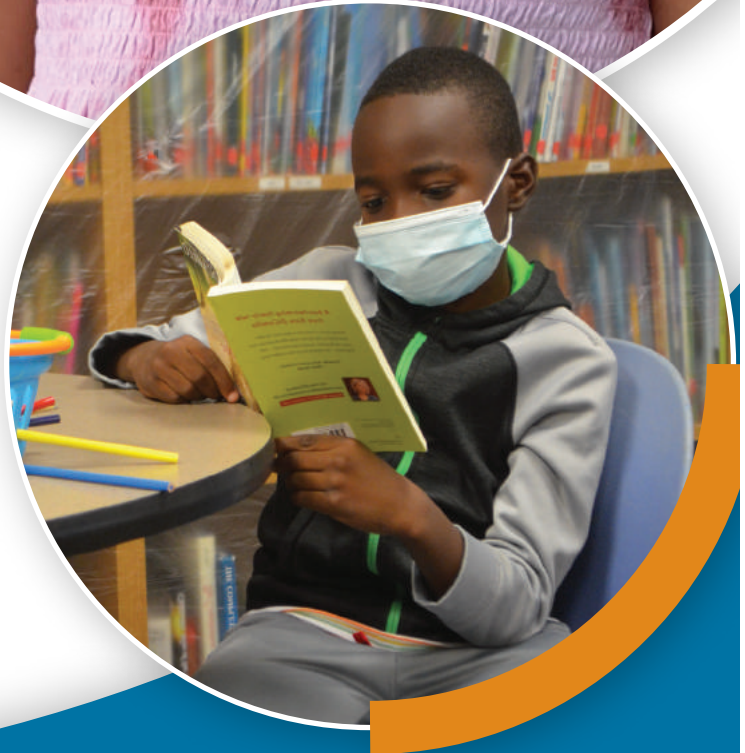

# Dear Friends,

In 2020 and 2021, we were challenged as a nation, as a community and as an organization to draw on our deepest reserves of resilience. The children and families we serve at the Boys & Girls Club of Collier County were disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. However, thanks to an unwavering commitment by staff, donors, partners and supporters, the Club responded, adapted and innovated to meet the urgent needs of Club members and our community.

For example, just three days after our in-person programs were forced to halt, we created virtual programming to keep Club members engaged and learning. These programs became a model nationwide and were shared with Boys & Girls Clubs from New York to California! We rapidly changed our health and safety protocols to safely allow programs to resume uninterrupted since May 2020. We offered mental health support and delivered hot meals, school supplies and hygiene products to our families. Additionally, we partnered with the local food bank to help alleviate hunger across our community. And yet, despite so many external challenges, our Club still grew by adding seven school-based sites in Immokalee so 750 children would not lose critical afterschool programming.

Of course, overcoming these challenges and adding new services required extreme determination, strength and grit. When facing any challenge, we simply look toward our Club members for inspiration. The children and teens we serve face incredible challenges daily, from poverty and peer pressure to rigorous academics and decisions about their futures. With connection and community, though, they can overcome any challenges. That is exactly what the Boys & Girls Club needed to achieve success during the past 18 months.

More than any period in our history, 2020 and 2021 illustrated with absolute clarity that it takes a community of partners, supporters and donors to keep our mission moving forward. Even as your world was turned upside down, you still supported our Club members. For that, we offer heartfelt gratitude to each of you.

For nearly 30 years, the Boys & Girls Club of Collier County has navigated times of difficulty and crisis to provide safe places and essential resources for Club members. Our core belief is stronger today than it's ever been – all children can achieve their greatest potential given the environment provided by our organization.

# Academic Success Focused



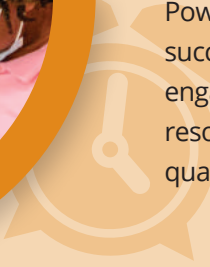
## STEM LEARNING LAB

The Cal Ripken Sr. Foundation STEM Center, generously funded by the Naples Children Education Foundation, is a beacon of learning for our members. Our members are able to code computers, build grand modes of transportation and create intricate electrical circuits. In a time when so much of their learning has been on a computer screen, the joy of hands-on learning is a welcome presence at our Club. Members visit the STEM Center at least once a week.



## POWER HOUR

Every day, Club members dedicate time after school to focus on homework or participate in differentiated educational activities. Power Hour helps Club members ages 6-18 achieve academic success by providing homework support, tutoring and technology engaged activities. The program gives Club members assistance, resources and guidance in a safe place and under the supervision of qualified staff and tutors.



## 21ST CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS

We are the largest out of school provider in Immokalee. In August 2020, the Boys & Girls Club of Collier County acquired 21st Century Community Learning Center After-School Programs. Miracle offers supplemental educational support to over 900 children (grades 3-12) at their day school sites. This is done through project and problem based learning in reading and language arts, math, science, arts & music, physical education, character education, drug prevention, and tutoring.



# Career Development Driven

## WORK-BASED LEARNING

Boys & Girls Club of Collier County has partnered with the Greater Naples Chamber of Commerce to bring a new work-based learning program for Club youth. This interactive virtual program will coincide with our club's College and Career Education program. Students will work with various career professionals on resume writing, interviewing skills, workplace etiquette, and job searching tips.



## MONEY MATTERS

Money Matters is a program designed to teach Members how to prepare for their financial future. This program teaches budgeting, saving, credit score facts, and debt management. In order to understand the growth of our members, pre and post surveys are administered to gauge their understanding of financial concepts.



## JUNIOR CULINARY ARTS PROGRAM

The Junior Culinary Arts Program provides teens 15 to 18 years old with meaningful work, life, and leadership skills through education and training. This career and technical job-readiness program provides Club teens the opportunity to work in one of our state of the art kitchens and on our Blue CanTEEN food truck as they build skills in the culinary arts, restaurant management, and entrepreneurship.





# 2021 Youth of the Year

This year's Youth of the Year celebration recognized the achievements of 10 teens who overcame incredibly challenging situations — homelessness, divorce, illness, poverty, drug abuse and more — to position themselves for a successful future. This year's winner, Lovensky Germain, has an awe-inspiring story to tell.

One of Lovensky's goals was to become Youth of the Year. Two years ago, he applied for the recognition, but was not selected as an honoree. Last year, he was named a finalist. This year, he finally accomplished his goal.

By virtue of winning our Youth of the Year, Lovensky has earned a college scholarship and advanced to the Boys & Girls Club's state competition where he was a finalist.

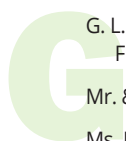

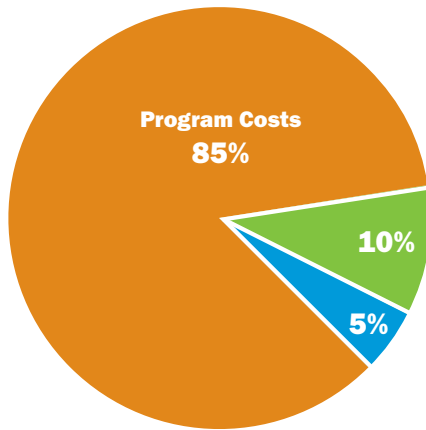
## ADULT VOLUNTEER – JOHN IANNUZZI

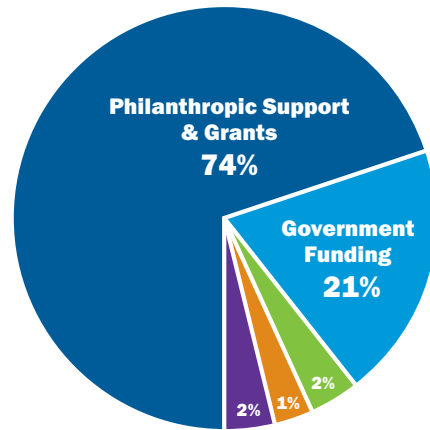
