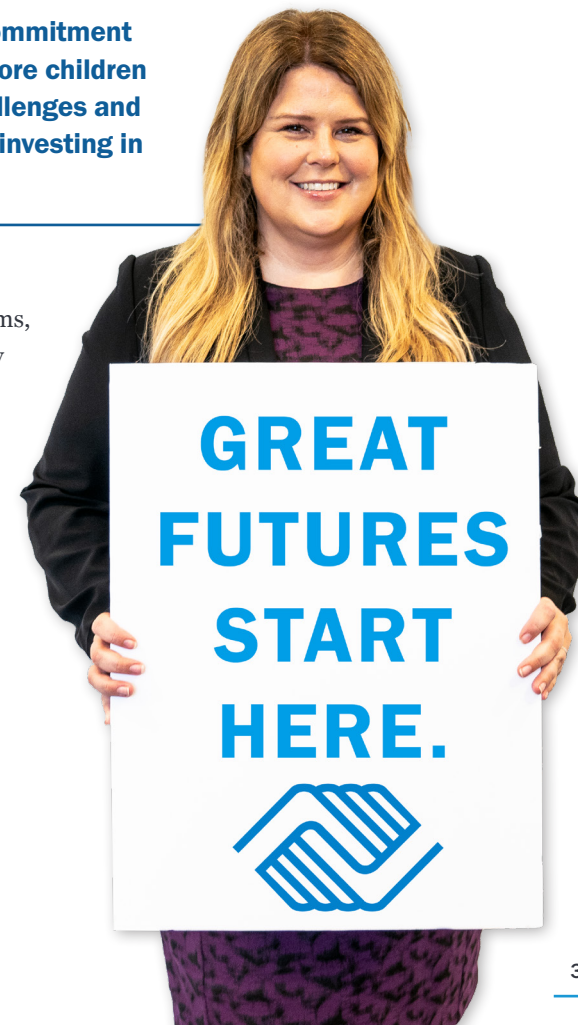

A key platform for Character & Leadership Development is the Torch Club, a program for members 11 to 13 years of age. The program utilizes career exploration camps, college tours, and financial literacy training provided through partnerships with local organizations including Florida Gulf Coast University, Florida Southwestern State College, and Taste the Impact. Participants gain a competitive advantage in the job market, cultivate essential soft skills, obtain hands-on career experiences, and complete safety training that reflects real-world workplaces. Networking opportunities with local business professionals through workshops and mentorships offer guidance and pave the way for teens to explore potential career pathways.

Through the diverse resources available at the Club, he has mastered the art of storytelling in essays, polished his professional demeanor, and learned the critical skill of networking. These skills have not only prepared him for the academic challenges ahead but have also laid a strong foundation for his future career.”



As a result of his Club experiences, Angelo believes he has identified a career path. “My time spent volunteering has really had a huge impact on what I want to accomplish in my future,” said Angelo.

“Helping younger Club members and their families really has led me to a career in psychology. Seeing the impact of speaking and creating connections with people, which can completely change their emotions, has truly been one of the biggest lessons I have learned during my time at the Club.”

**My son Rafael was 10 years old when he first attended a Boys & Girls Club of Collier County's summer camp in July 2021.** We had just moved here from Orlando, and before Orlando, we had moved from Brazil. We had no family or friends here, and I was consumed with finding daycare and making this huge transition less stressful for Rafael. I was concerned with finding a safe and affordable summer camp, and after-school care where Rafael could make new friends. My new neighbor knew of the Club and called for me. She spoke with Yv'Rose, and with that first call and every other call after, all of the staff were kind, helpful, and made me and Rafael feel at home.

When I picked Rafael up after his day at the Club, he was beaming and burst out: "It was the most amazing place ever – I made friends!" He shared with me that the staff helped him get involved with all of the activities and that he wanted to go to the Club forever. Rafael jumped out of bed each day (and still does), excited to go to Boys & Girls Club. The Club gave him a home away from home, many friends, and fostered his love of soccer. So much so that the skills he developed there just helped him achieve his dream of earning a spot on the Azzurri Storm Soccer Team. As a parent, I am beyond grateful to Boys & Girls Club of Collier

Meet Maxwell

The Health, Wellness & Life Skills programs at Boys & Girls Club of Collier County provide members with the opportunity to learn healthy habits, create strong relationships, and build the interpersonal skills necessary to successfully navigate through life. Members engage in team building activities, nutrition education, and programs to empower them to make informed decisions. Through these programs, the Club empowers young minds to embrace habits that nourish their bodies, minds, and spirits.

Maxwell is an example of one of our teen members who positively receives this guidance as he keeps his health and social skills in mind. With plans to become a professional athlete, either playing soccer or being a kicker for a football team, Maxwell ensures that he applies he is learning to become a healthier and overall better person. The Law Enforcement Against Drugs (L.E.A.D.) program, made possible through partnerships with the Florida Alliance of Boys & Girls Clubs, the Florida Department of Children & Families, and the Collier County Sheriff's Office, taught Maxwell the importance of putting his values first when facing peer pressure. His knowledge and values were tested when a peer—someone he called a friend—showed him vapes in his backpack and asked Maxwell to keep it a secret. "I knew it was the wrong thing to do and told an adult," Maxwell shared.

He credits L.E.A.D. and the participating officers for teaching him how to make healthier decisions and stand up for what he knows is right.



The Health, Wellness & Life Skills programs have also taught Maxwell the importance of working with his peers as a team. "When Ms. Edline [a Youth Development Professional] had us doing team building activities, it taught me how important it is to use teamwork when participating in activities. When everyone works together, it can also be more fun," Maxwell said. Maxwell's goal to be an athlete on a professional team will require these skills to create a cohesive team.

Maxwell shared that the Healthy Habits Program has encouraged him to take care of his physical health. He is eating healthier, working out, and playing more sports.

The Club is committed to offering programs that help youth become successful adults by building strong decision-making skills, developing awareness of physical health and healthy eating habits, and learning how to manage emotions and build relationships.

## Meet Isaiah

What does determination, hard work and leadership look like? Look no further than teen member Isaiah, a beneficiary of Boys & Girls Club of Collier County athletics programs, who has taken the lessons learned on the playing field and applied them to his everyday life.

Isaiah never imagined the basic principles and fundamentals learned from participating in athletics at the Club would show up in everything he does.

“Playing sports has definitely taught me a lot of things that I’ve added to my character,” Isaiah said. “These include learning how to communicate, how to be a better teammate and nicer to my friends, and how to deal with setbacks and disappointments. Sports is my favorite part of the Club.”

A member of the Bolch Club, Isaiah has been attending since elementary school and has become involved in a number of teen activities that are offered. However, the highlight of his day is when he is able to spend an hour participating in various sports activities including basketball, flag football and baseball. Baseball is his favorite sport, but his skills have also grown tremendously in basketball and flag football, where he is often selected by teammates as the captain. In the past, Isaiah admits he was not a team player and tried to do everything on his own. With core values instilled in him during Club athletics, he has transformed his way of thinking.

**“I had to learn the hard way that you can’t do everything by yourself and that being a team player will always equal success,” he said.**

“It’s more fun for everybody when I play sports the right way, and it’s easier for my friends to respect me and trust me for doing that.”

One especially proud moment occurred during the Cal Ripken Senior Foundation Naples Baseball Camp. He helped one of his friends who was a beginner at baseball to better understand the techniques and fundamentals while playing and performing drills. Although he put on an



impressive performance in front of the coaches and Florida Southwestern State College softball players, he was more proud of helping his friend improve his skills.

“Being able to help my friend with hitting stances, fielding, throwing with velocity, and even putting on the glove properly to catch fastballs, was a cool thing to do,” he said. “By the time we played games, I saw that he was more comfortable and confident playing with the other campers. It is something I’ll never forget.”

“I’m looking forward to next year when I can try out for the baseball team at my school and I feel more confident than ever that I can make the team this time,” Isaiah said. “The best thing that [Athletic Director] Coach Nigel taught me is your discipline, determination and dedication will determine your destination. As I get older, I understand it more. I wouldn’t have been able to learn these things if I wasn’t a member of the Boys & Girls Club. I’m forever grateful to be here.”

Tim's involvement was not merely a matter of philanthropy as he possessed a deep-seated passion for fostering growth and opportunity in the lives of the Club's youth.



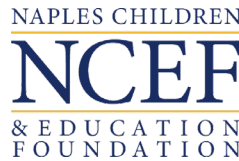
